The 24th Congress of your party is being held in the year when South Asia is facing serious agressiveness from religoius extremist political forces and authoritarian regimes. Simultaniously, the whole world is experiencing imperialist war mongering in Ukraine, Palestine and many parts of the globe. We all understand that it is an outcry of global capitalism which is already in an obvious condition of selfdecaying. Continious decline of US dollar monopoly and rise of Global South strongly proclaims potentials of socialism. Our Party calls upon left and democratic forces of this region to enhance struggle to build up alternative 'pro-people currency exchange system' to combat imperialist currency monopoly.

We are attentive of the importance of your congress. It is going to be held under a complex situation in your country. The 24th Congress of your Party meets at a time when BJP led communal government deepens its attack on working class of India as well as against communist and progressive forces. The aggressive continuation of the Hindutva drive by the BJP government and its allies through various State-sponsored activities, such as the inauguration of the Ram temple in Ayodhya in January 2024 and the passing of various laws in the BJP-ruled states targeting Muslim minorities explicitly exposed violation of federal character of the Indian constitution and heavily disrupt the communal harmony in India. Moreover, such policies providing advantages to other religious fundamentalists in this region. At the same time they are aggressively implementing neo liberal economic policy, strengthening communal-corporate nexus and maneuvering to make India a junior strategic partner of USA and imperialism. In addition, Indian far right political forces along with their neo fascist communal allies utilizing Indian ruling bourgeoisie to advance a domineering approach to neighboring countries including Bangladesh. Their disregard to compliance of International Laws for resolving 54 jointriver water sharing with Bangladesh through peaceful manner depriving working-class of both countries and increasing difficulties. Indeed the assault of capitalism-imperialism in this region calls for a new regional coalition of all anti-imperialist forces of the region, for raising to a qualitatively new level of unity, cohesion, cooperation and coordination of the struggles of these forces all over the world.

We are confident that your party which has a long and glorious history and tradition and a matured leadership that will be able to formulate appropriate political and tactical line in order to lead the Indian working class and other working people of India in their struggle against this danger and towards emancipation of the toiling masses of India. In often difficult contexts, our common struggles are more important than ever, working to innovate and build alternatives to capitalism, emancipatory alternatives driven by the desire for social progress for all peoples.

The escalation of competition and antagonism between imperialist powers for the appropriation and re-division of markets, has already led to wars in various parts of the world as well as the catastrophic degradation of the environment...

Imperialism's war in Ukraine since February 2022, and the genocidal war waged by Israel on the Palestinian people both in Gaza and the West Bank since 7 October 2023 are two obvious examples. The reality that either of these wars could easily expand beyond the frontiers of the nations involved and beyond the scope of conventional warfare - with all the dire ramifications this entails for people beyond the immediate belligerents - underlines our pressing responsibility to oppose the imperialist drive to war.

Dear Comrades, the struggle for peace and progress in the Middle East is currently more urgent than it has been for decades. The forces of imperialism, in a quest to maintain their domination of this hugely important region, steadfastly resist any material progressive change from taking place there - including the recognition and implementation of the most basic and righteous demands of its peoples for justice, as well as full and unencumbered self-determination and sovereignty. In this context, militarism, authoritarianism, fascistic trends, assaults on the peoples' rights and living standards and war are increasingly becoming central to the policies of these ruling classes. Their fundamental unity in sustaining the genocide against the Palestinian people and in escalating war in the Middle East is a clear sign of the profoundly reactionary and warmongering nature of imperialism, whether of the US, of the UK or of the European Union.
